Welcome to the AAD Boy Scout religious award training for 2008. To be eligible for this program you must have completed the sixth grade, have been active in a troop/crew for six months and be a Boy Scout of Catholic faith. The purpose of Ad Altare Dei ("To The Altar of God") program is to help Catholic Scouts of the Roman Rite develop a fully Christian way of life in the faith community. The program culminates with a formal court of honor held at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist.

The AAD program is organized in chapters based on the seven Sacraments. The course includes a combination of classroom work, homework, and service work as well as field trips. Students need to purchase a workbook for the course and parents are encouraged to purchase the instructors guide to help with homework (approx. \$10 for both). Books will be available from the courselors on the first day of class. We required that students wear their tan uniform shirt and bring a notebook and pencil to class. We will begin the program on **Sunday**, **August 24th 2008** and will be meeting at the Lower Old Church Hall at Assumption in Broadview Hts.
